SHOPPING AREAS

INGLEWOOD Calgary's oldest neighbourhood is the place for antiques, collectibles, interior furnishings and imports. Also some lovely boutiques, fashion and specialty stores. A 20-min walk or 5-min cab ride from the Calgary Tower. Store hours vary. Along 9 Ave SE between 10 and 14 St, 266-6369. **Map 2, E8**

KENSINGTON This neighbourly area across the Bow River from downtown has a collection of specialty shops including antiques, books, toys, art, crafts, fashion and more. Store hours vary. 10 St NW at Kensington Road, 283-4810. **Map 2, C3**
