

Frequently Asked Questions

What benefits will Qeva elk velvet antler provide?

Five major areas:

- Arthritis treatment

When should Qeva start working?

- Qeva should produce results within 2-4 weeks
- An initial purchase supply of at least one month is recommended

What is the recommended dosage?

- For the initial loading phase of 30 days- 1 capsule/50lbs. Of body weight is the optimum dosage
- After the first 30 days, dosage levels may be reduced according to the person's needs, usually 2-3 capsules per day is the minimum requirement

When should Qeva be taken?

- Qeva should be taken in the morning

Does Qeva have any side effects?

- To date we have not encountered any customers reporting side effects from taking Qeva

Compare Qeva with prescription pain relievers and other counter pain relievers for joint problems

NSAIDS (Non-steroid anti-inflammatory drugs) are common prescription and over the counter pain relievers. They include such common drugs as acetaminophen, aspirin, naproxen, oxaprofen, nabumetone, diclofenac and ibuprofen. The problem with these drugs is that they could produce serious side effects like liver damage, kidney damage and bleeding from the gastrointestinal tract, just to name a few. That means NSAIDS could be doing more bad to you than good! Qeva elk velvet antler will not produce side effects. In addition, NSAIDS only mask the underlying problems by relieving the pain associated with the problem. NSAIDS do not address the cause of the problem. Recent research shows that elk velvet antler contains compounds that help repair the cartilage damage in joint problems. Therefore EVA targets and focuses on the root of the problem to relieve pain rather than only the symptoms.

Can Qeva be taken with other types of medication?

There have been no reports of any adverse effects when taking elk velvet antler with other types of medication. However, Qeva does suggest that you consult your nutritionist or physician before you take Qeva with other medication.

Are there other added ingredients in Qeva?

No, Qeva is an all-natural product. Qeva does not contain any added fillers, artificial preservatives, colors or flavors.

How does Qeva compare to the other products that contain Glucosamine and Chondroitin Sulfate?

Many of the other products that contain Glucosamine and Chondroitin Sulfate are made from animal by products such as shellfish, shark cartilage etc. Production of these products involves the slaughtering of these animals.
